<u>Lot Clean up</u>: 46 letters were sent out concerning lot clean up. This past winter "blessed" Safari with an abundance of rain!! Now we have an abundance of weeds and grasses appearing! As these weeds and grasses grow and bloom they are spreading their seeds. Please remember it is member's responsibility to keep their lots up throughout the year and not just for the Memorial Day clean up. Did you know that 1 dandelion flower can produce 54 – 172 seeds? One dandelion plant can produce up to 2000 seeds over a season.

<u>New phone number:</u> To save money, Safari is switching to a new phone system. We have a new phone number. Please note the new phone number <u>360-355-9512</u>.

<u>Tarps:</u> At the May Membership meeting, tarps were discussed. Input was given from the membership. The Board then put together the following rules for tarps in Safari.

## Tarps & covers may be used according to the following rules:

- 1. Custom fitted covers for vehicles/RVs are permitted as long as they are of a solid color and in good repair. Using tape for repair cuts is not allowed unless approved by the board.
- 2. Blue tarps may be only used in an emergency to protect property from leaks. The repair must be completed within 30 days and the tarp removed. The board may approve an additional 30 days use of the blue tarp but only once.
- 3. Brown and white solid color tarps may be used to cover vehicles for a period of 90 days.
- 4. No tarp may be used as a wall or fence substitute.
- 5. Tarps of any color may be used to cover items like woodpiles if they are not visible from the street.
- 6. Tarps must be secured such that they do not blow in the wind and produce noise.
- 7. Violators will be given 10 days to correct any violation of these rules. If the violation is not corrected in that period, a fine of \$100 is assessed. If the violation is not corrected within an additional 20 days, an additional \$500 fine is assessed. If the violation is not corrected within an additional 30 days thereafter, the membership will be foreclosed. These rules were adopted on June 20, 2017 and will go into effect on July 20, 2017.
